Submission will be through the EasyChair system (https://easychair.org/cfp/ICID2024WS). All abstracts and papers will be blind-reviewed by the program committee. All accepted abstracts will be invited for the presentation at the conference. Selected proceedings of the conference will be published in Springer, CCIS series.
